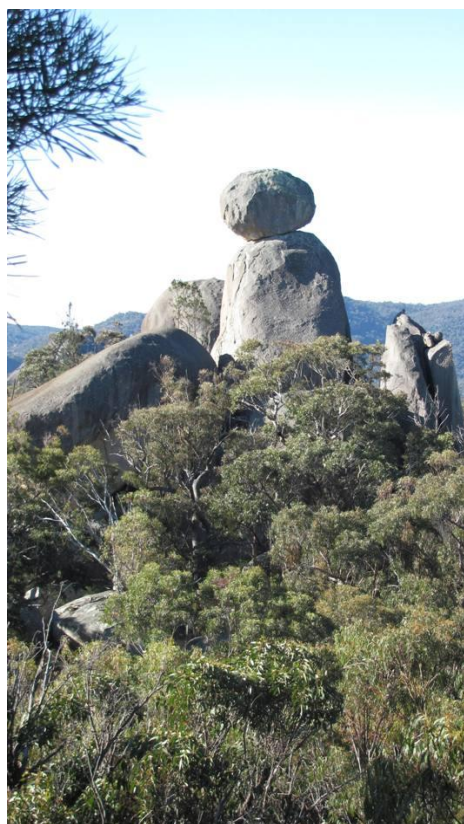
ATTENTION
